What is WATEA?

The Wisconsin Automotive & Truck Education Association brings likeminded transportation businesses, educational institutions, community organizations, and individuals together to create innovative solutions for increasing workforce opportunities in the transportation industry.

WATEA's Mission: To improve awareness of career paths and opportunities in the automotive/truck industry; and to promote technical and continuing training, educational development, and certification for workers in the automotive and truck industry.

History of WATEA: In the late 1990's, a small group of business and educational leaders joined forces to save the Automotive Technician training program at a local technical college. Through this experience, the group discovered the power of their combined influence and, in 2000, the Wisconsin Automotive & Truck Education Association was formed. Since that time, businesses and organizations who might be competitors elsewhere have collaborated to achieve their shared goals of increasing transportation industry training opportunities.

In 2011, WATEA launched the *Wheels to Work* program to provide reliable vehicles to low-income workers. In 2019, *Commute2Careers* was created to give shuttle rides to new employees lacking transportation to work. In 2022, *Commute2Careers* partnered with Mid-State Tech to shuttle students with transportation barriers to school.

Key Programs & Initiatives

- **WATEA Student Scholarships** provide thousands of dollars in tuition each year, enabling multiple students to pursue transportation-related training programs at regional technical colleges.
- **Technical College Programming** ensures current and future employees have access to up-to-date training in the fields of Auto Tech, Collision & Repair, Diesel Tech, and CDL/Driving. Businesses also benefit from apprenticeship programs and by participating in industry advisory groups.
- **K-12 Auto/Tech Ed Programs** excite the next generation of employees through Youth Apprenticeship, job shadowing, internships, and entry-level jobs.
- Wheels to Work provides affordable, no-interest loans to low-income individuals who need a vehicle or vehicle repairs to access a job.
- **Commute2Careers** gives free shuttle rides to Mid-State Technical College students with transportation barriers so they can get to their classes, save money, & complete their degrees to enter the workforce.

Annual Events & Activities

- The **Fore the Road Charity Golf Event** is WATEA's annual fundraiser. Spend a day on the golf course, then enjoy a night of networking, food & beverages, live music, fireworks and more for a great cause!
- WATEA's Annual Meeting is a FREE event featuring updates on current transportation workforce
 initiatives, a keynote speaker highlighting key industry topics, and excellent networking opportunities.
- Transportation Careers Night shows students the benefits of working in the transportation industry.
